Luke 1:46–48

Mary responds with praise.

Magnifies = praises greatly

Rejoices = deep joy

Humble = lowly

Praise begins before the outcome.

Luke 1:49–50

Mary recognizes God's power and mercy.

Mighty One = powerful God

Holy = set apart

Mercy = compassion

God's character brings comfort.

Luke 1:51–53

God reverses human expectations.

Scattered = broken pride

Lifted = restored

Hungry = needy

God sees injustice and responds.

Luke 1:54–55

God keeps His promises.

Helped = supported

Remembered = faithful

Promise = unbroken word

God finishes what He starts.

Core Truth: Praise anchors faith even before circumstances change.
