Session 1: Order Before the Miracle

Luke 1:1–4

God gives an orderly account so faith can be understood.

Orderly = structured

Certainty = confidence

God values clarity.

Luke 1:5–7

Zechariah and Elizabeth are faithful and still waiting.

Righteous = faithful

Waiting ≠ punishment

God is present in long seasons.

Luke 1:8–10

Zechariah serves while prayers rise.

Chosen = God-timed

Incense = prayer

God moves during prayer.

Luke 1:11–20

God speaks. Fear appears. Silence follows.

Afraid = overwhelmed

Silence = reflection

God is still working.

Luke 1:21–25

Elizabeth recognizes God privately.

Private faith comes first

God restores dignity.

Luke 1:26–30

God speaks to Mary.

Favored = graced

With you = not alone

God chooses ordinary people.

Luke 1:31–38

Mary responds with obedience.

Servant = willing

According = trust

Faith says yes.

Luke 1:39–45

Joy confirms God's promise.

Joy = assurance

Blessed = approved

God confirms His word.

Luke 1:46–55

Mary praises God.

Magnifies = praises

Mercy = compassion

God keeps promises.

Luke 1:56–60

Waiting ends. God acts.

Obedience = trust

Naming = identity

God finishes what He starts.
